Off-Broadway: *In the Heights*—nine Drama Desk nominations, including Outstanding Music and Outstanding Lyrics, and won the award for Outstanding Ensemble Performance; the Lucille Lortel Award and Outer Critics Circle Award for Best Musical; the Obie Award for Outstanding Music and Lyrics; and a Theatre World Award for Outstanding Debut Performance and the Clarence Derwent Award, both for Miranda's performance.

He is the recipient of the 2007 ASCAP

Richard Rodgers New Horizons Award.
